**Who Are We?** All adults in the parish are members of Sacred Heart Altar Society.

**What do we do?** We are the Martha's of the Bible...behind the scenes, getting the work done. We launder and press all the altar linens, Priest's albs, pay for all the candles used for the Liturgies and the votive candles, all altar breads and wine, polish the brass vessels, candle holders, censer and other special things used to enrich the Liturgies throughout the year. Weekly the altar areas are vacuumed and dusted, 2 or 3 women or men volunteer for a month a year, of their choice.

We furnish and serve funeral luncheons for parish families if they wish. Members of the parish donate the food for the meal and families can make a donation in appreciation.

**Membership:** Dues are \$10 a year and can be put in an envelope and marked "Altar Society" and put in the collection basket. The monies are used to pay for all the liturgical supplies. We encourage all households in the parish to participate.
